Clinical faculty preapproval of such arrangements or coursework is required and must be sought via a petition submitted to the Director of Clinical Training.

Asterisks denote courses that partially\* or fully\*\* satisfy each core area's criteria. In cases of partial fulfillment, students should confer with the Director of Clinical Training to ensure that their proposed combination of courses is sufficient for the requirement.
